

kidnapped as a child, to


members of her original family.

- Waters, Sarah Recommended for readers wanting something out of the norm. Historical fiction with more than a touch of


the risqué.

# Undground Railroad: A Novel


- Whitehead, Colson This era well known to many is brought to life through the personal experiences of indi-


