
Oct 16 - 22 is National Friends of Libraries Week!




Reading Buddies

Reciprocal Lending: your digital library just got bigger!



Reciprocal lending with Overdrive/Libby

Your digital library just got bigger! Reciprocal lending is now available for all MARINet patrons.

What's reciprocal lending?

It's a lot like Link+, but for Overdrive eBooks and audiobooks. You can borrow items from partner libraries that **aren't checked out or on hold**, and they can borrow from us!

How does it work?

In the Libby app or Overdrive website, go to your account and add a new library card by searching for 'Peninsula Library System' or 'NorthNet.' When you're asked for your library card information, scroll down to see partner libraries, select San Rafael Public Library, and sign in with your San Rafael Public Library card number and password/pin.

In addition to this amazing partnership, we've also got access to over 4,000 comics, graphic novels, and manga—always available, no holds, just like our magazines! These titles are for all ages and include popular reads such as Minecraft, Avatar, Cuphead, Stranger Things, Paper Girls, Black Panther, Star Wars as well as manga titles like Berserk, Oh My Goddess!, Blade of the Immortal, and many more.
