### You Love Your Library and It Shows!

This past year was one of change, creativity, and deep community connection, and it showed in how you used your library. While our Downtown Library operated from a temporary Pop-Up location on 4th Street, our Pickleweed and Northgate branches remained active community hubs, together ensuring library services stayed accessible and welcoming across the city.

In a city of nearly 60,000 residents, more than 32,000 library cardholders made the most of what the library has to offer. Across all locations, you checked out more than 379,000 items, connected with library staff for nearly 39,000 questions and research needs, and helped share our collections far beyond our city through 21,000 interlibrary loans. Programs also brought people together in big ways, with 503 programs offered and 17,406 attendees gathering for storytimes, workshops, author talks, and community events for all ages.

Taken together, these numbers tell a powerful story. Whether you visited us at the 4th Street Pop-Up, stopped by Pickleweed or Northgate, or connected with us online, you showed that the library is more than a building, it's a shared community space powered by curiosity, learning, and fun. Thank you for loving your library this year. We can't wait to keep that love growing in the year ahead.
